Aviator Flight Training has moved to Cable Airport this June! You may have seen their T-6 Texan sitting outside the General Store and their Cessna 170 and Citabria in transit in late May and early June. Starting June first they moved into Hangar U on the South West corner of the Airport.

Aviator Flight Training was started in 2007 in at Fullerton Airport by **Daniel Wotring**. We have been conducting tailwheel training, transition to classic, antique, warbird trainer type aircraft and formation training ever since. We specialize in teaching airmanship skills that are slowly being lost. But that's not to be said you wont have a ton of fun learning new skills, while making you more confident and comfortable in your everyday flying!

Our fleet includes a Cessna 170B, Citabria 7GCBC, Great Lakes Biplane, Boeing PT-17 Stearman, North American SNJ-5 (T-6D) Texan and Douglas DC-3 (currently at Riverside Airport). Both the Citabria and Great Lakes are available for solo rental after checkout.

Aviator Flight Training has a well honed syllabus for tailwheel transition as well as transition to each of their aircraft as well as Warbird Lead in Training, High Performance, Complex, Formation Training to FAST standards and soon to come Upset Training. We strive to make your experience efficient, cost effective and FUN!

Along with training we also have FAA approval for rides and scenic flights! Those flights are available in the Cessna 170, Great Lakes, Stearman, Texan and DC-3!
