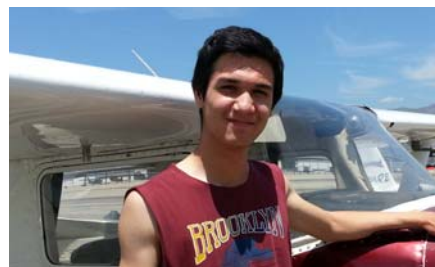

CREDIT CARDS NOW BEING TAKEN!

The Airport Office now takes credit cards. If you would like to pay your hanger rent via credit card, feel free to visit us to make a payment. Also, we now are able to do automated billing via your credit card. Again, visit us to sign up.

RUNWAY PAVEMENT PROJECT

The airport has received approximately \$450,000 in FAA grant funds to repave, restripe and renumber the runway as well as the south taxiway. Initially, the project was scheduled to kick off the week of November 10th with an alternate time period being the week of November 17th. Unfortunately, as of this writing, the contractor has yet to confirm either week. Absence of confirmation of either proposed week, the project will most likely take place after the Cable Air Faire. Once the Airport Office has confirmed the date, notices will be posted throughout the airport so you may do your planning accordingly.

VASI UPDATE

We are getting closer to getting the VASI back up and running. The FAA has been out no less than four times to measure the trees to the east of Runway 24. As of October 28th, there are two trees that are still penetrating into the 4 degree VASI obstacle clearance surface. The Airport Office is working with the homeowner's association where the trees are located to get these trees topped. Hopefully, the FAA will be able to flight test the VASI in November and get it back on for your safety.

We are having great support for bringing a wide variety of pre-1950 airplanes, both civilian and warbirds to our

Almost all of it was returned to the fund 6 months later, but it could have gone another way. This year, the FAA will not charge any up front fees. YEH! We will still pay, but hopefully only a few hundred dollars.

The Not So Good News:

Nobody will be allowed in, or about, the North Hangars during the Air Faire. From 8:30 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday, there will be no one allowed near their hangars or airplanes. Most South side hangars will have very limited, or no access on Saturday and Sunday from 8:30am -4:00 pm. There will be a NO FLY TFR over the airport during these times also.

Further information will be in the December Cable Gram with maps and access procedures.

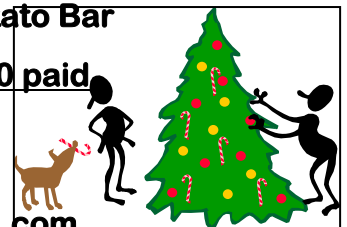

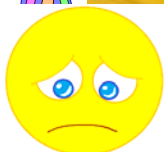
