On August 2, many Cableites joined Judy at Rialto to help celebrate this sad event. Not only because of the move, but the loss of another airport to redevelopment.

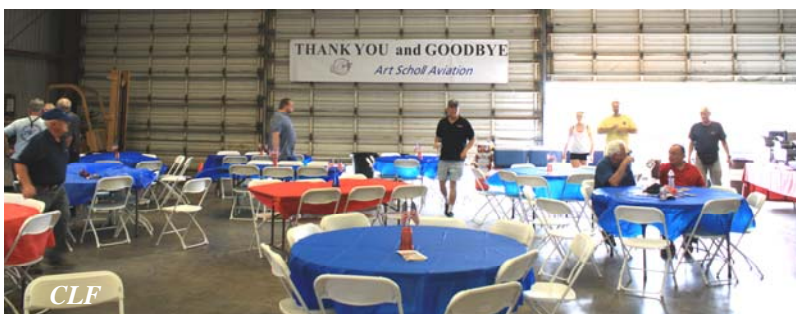
