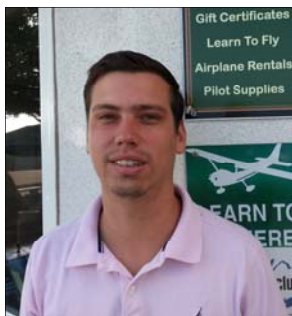

**2355 DAYS: A POW'S STORY** is a story of survival and resilience in the face of an ordeal which seemed to have no end, 2,355 Days tells of the author's torture, deprivation, loneliness, fear, and boredom in his harrowing six and a half years in a North Vietnamese prisoner-of-war camp. A wrenching reminder of the price that some must pay to serve their country.

**SO YOU WANT TO BE A FERRY PILOT** is made up of nineteen true short stories about ferrying airplanes from one part of the world to another. Each flight has something about it that wasn't planned. Unexpected heart stopping engine failures, weather that went from CAVU (Clear and Visibility Unlimited) to Oh MY God!!, interception by armed foreign fighters, arrest by third world police or anything that old Mister Murphy can throw your face.

**THE BOYS WHO BRING IN THE CROP** is about a group of amateur marijuana smugglers who made seven flights to Colombia and back in the mid seventies. They made and spent piles of money and never got caught. They were smart, planned well and had lots of dumb luck. It's a fast paced book, wild flying, wild living, it all takes place in less than one year.
